Subject: Solar Systems Update

Dear Jon,

I just wanted to update you on the performance of our solar system. Since the 6<sup>th</sup> of April the system has generated 55 kWh more electricity than we have used. Our BGE bill over this period has been \$7.68/month. This is due to a minimum BGE Electric Delivery Service charge. During the winter months, January 7<sup>th</sup> to April 6<sup>th</sup> the BGE bill averaged \$130/month.

Dow Chemical also referred us to SOLSYSTEMS for the sale of the SRECs (Solar Renewable Energy Credits) our system generates. When the SRECs are taken into account the solar system has actually generated a \$230 credit since the system was switched on.

During this period we have had the Geo Thermal HVAC system thermostat set to 72/76 degrees for winter/summer. The solar shingles versus the solar panels also provide the added benefit of a very unobtrusive appearance.

We are very pleased with the performance of our solar system and would recommend the installation of solar shingles to others.
